

Pi Day was celebrated on 3-14 in Mrs. Miles' Class by participating in a variety of Pi related activities. Students watched the Ted Talk, *Pi with Pies* and then recreated the activity using circular candies and finding the ratio of their circumference and diameter. Students had a Pi Vocabulary Challenge listing as many words that started with or contained "pi" in three minutes. Students had baskets of circular objects and round food items, and used various methods to measure the circumference and diameter to see if the ratio came to 3.14. Students were able to make a circular sun catcher with the digits of pi listed around the outside edge and also competed with Two Truths and A Pi. Other center activities included a Pi Digital Scavenger Hunt, writing Pi-Ku Poems, Pi Sudoku and Pi fact sheet that they could also color. The class ended with a special treat of eating pie!




